Saturday


- 12.45pm for 1.00pm Concours Judging in the pit area. Both Ringmasters and R6-B. Followed by photos of models and group photo with their builders.
- 1:30pm till 2:30 pm Ringmaster flying on center C/L field. (main R/C strip closed)
- 2:30pm till 3:30pm on the main R/C strip is the time to fly the R6-B challenge. (center C/L circle closed)
- 4.45pm for 5:00pm David Owen Memorial Free Flight Scramble. On F/F Field. Rules the same as last year

Sunday

8.00am for 9.00– Plank Racing. Both Cowra and Super Plank. On center C/L circle.

Rules the same as last year.

NB: If your model isn't scrutineered by the 9.00am start time you will not be permitted to fly.

Ringmaster

The worldwide annual Ringmaster Flyathon is on October 5th & 6th this year. So for Oily Hand the C/L model of the meet is Ringmaster.

There are actually two Ringmasters. The one by Harry Williamson in the photo on the front cover and the more well known oneMatt Kania designed for Sterling models. Both are from 1951 and history still can't decide which is the 'original'.

R6-B

Designed by New Zealander Allan Rowe in 1953, R6-B is basically a 60" span powered glider. It is reputed to be aerobatic.

2019 Oily Hand Bulletin

Pilot's briefing notes are on the website and will be at registration. You will be required to sign that you have read them when you register.

A couple of things have changed for this year.

First up we have registered our field with CASAR and it now has an area approval. The details of what this entails are in the enclosed pilot's briefing notes. It should mean no changes to how all of us fly. Apart from that blimp flying chappie at dusk who shall remain un-named.

The second thing is we have cut back the number of events. This will free up more time and space for sport flying which is what Oily Hand is all about.

The Oily Hand tee shirts were popular last year. We are having them done again this year with a new and highly desirable design. They will be available by pre order only. Use the enclosed form or download one from the club's website.

Shirts can only be picked up at Oily Hand.

There will be a Carrier Deck flying demo at lunchtime on Saturday. David Murrell is overseeing this. If you have a carrier deck model and would like to join in, David says "the more the merrier."

Jacko tells me he has only one of his old mate Big Kev's extensive collection of NIB Schlossersleft. We have decided it will be the prize for the pilots draw this year. You must be at the presentation when the draw is made to collect the engine if you win. No sneaking off early!

Apart from that the same old engine rules apply; R/C models must be powered by a diesel of any capacity, or a glow of less than 1cc.

C/L models must be diesel or open exhaust glow.

F/F models can be diesel, small glow, CO2 or towline glider.

Registration
