Registration

Real Aeromodelling for you?

Oily Hand is for proper aeromodellers. Yep in an age of instant foam models, electrics and self-piloting drones, Oily Hand brings you traditional aeromodelling where you get to chew the glue off your fingers, sniff burnt castor and get your fingers whacked by a nasty little engine.

Try F/F, R/C, C/L or have a go at all three. Just so long as you adhere to the Oily Hand Engine Formula:

R/C models must be powered by a diesel of any capacity or a glow of less than 1cc.

C/L models must be diesel or open exhaust glow.

F/F models can be diesel, small glow, CO2 or towline glider.

After 2:30pm on Sunday you are welcome to stay on and fly any type of model including foamies, electrics and drones with CMAC's non-oily members.
