SAMS CABIN SPORT MODEL SCRAMBLE RULES OILY HAND

Model:

Any cabin, or semi scale sport model designed before 1960.

Engine:

Any engine up to 1.5cc or replica thereof produced before 1960. (MP Jet 0.6cc Classic diesel engines also allowed.) Fuel allowance 3cc as per Mills .75 & MP Jet 0.6 fixed tanks

Duration:

The event will be run over 30 minutes. The CD will call the start and finish times.

Timekeeping:

Pilot must provide their own timekeeper who will write down the flight times in minutes and seconds only on the provided score sheet.

Score sheets to be returned to the CD at the end of the event.

All flight times to be recorded.

Minimum flight time to count is 30sec.

Maximum flight time 180sec (3min)

Flight Line:

Models to be launched from flight line into wind. Models must land behind the flight line and not closer than 15ft from the flight line. This 15ft safety line and the flight line will be marked. If any part of the model crosses the 15ft line on landing the flight score will be zero.

The model may land anywhere else behind this line.

Transmitters must remain on the flight line whilst the model is retrieved. The models engine must be stopped *before* it is picked up for return to the flight line.

The motor must be hand started on the flight line.

No runners allowed. Pilots must retrieve their own models.

Winner:

Will be the pilot whose validtime scores add up to the longest flight time achieved in the 30min.
