

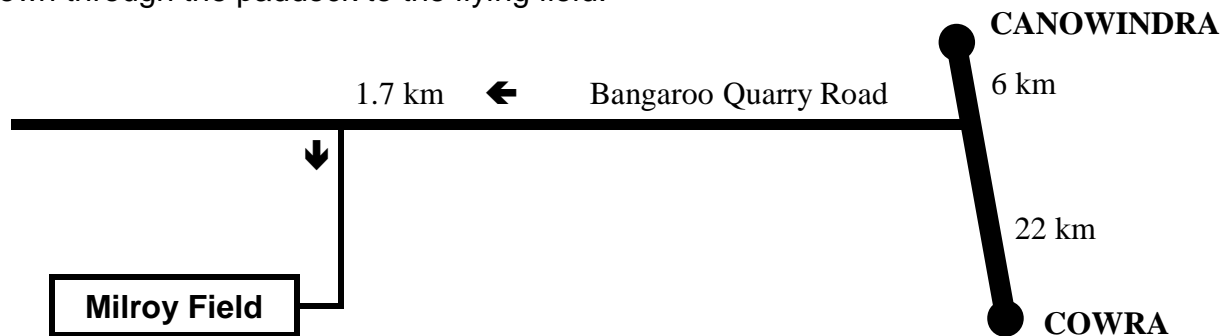
# SPARKS 2014

## Cowra Model Aircraft Club

**ELECTRIC ONLY fly-in. Sunday, 13 April 2014**

**LOCATION** - Milroy Field, Canowindra.

**DIRECTIONS** - 6km out the Cowra road, or 22km from Cowra side. Turn up Bangaroo Quarry Road (look for the "Roses Etcetera" sign). Go another 1.7km, you will see a sign on the left. Follow the track down through the paddock to the flying field.



**PROGRAM** - 08:00am - Gates open for pilot registration and setting up your gear.  
09:00am - Morning session starts with heli's and multirotor's.  
10:30am - Fixed wing aircraft flying till lunch.  
12:00pm - BBQ LUNCH with tea, coffee or can of fizz.  
01:00pm - Afternoon session starts with heli's and multi's.  
02:00pm - Fixed wing aircraft flying.  
03:00pm - Official activities end.

### NEED TO KNOW -

- There is a \$10.00 registration fee for all pilots. This also gets you lunch.
- All pilots must register and show their valid MAAA or AMAS membership card before flying.
- The Safety Officer has the right to ground any pilot flying in an unsafe manner.
- All attendees are expected to act in a courteous and friendly manner.
- BBQ lunch available for all attendees. Snacks and drinks will be available all day.
- You will need to bring your own chair and other comforts. Toilet facilities at the field.
- Pilots need to bring their own charging equipment. No power available at the field.
- For those who charge from their car battery, we ask that they do so in a safe manner, and suggest that charging equipment be placed outside the engine bay on a small table.

### WE HAVE RULES -

- The flight line runs east - west. ALL flight must be done south of the flight line in the display area. Strictly no flying over the pits, car park or spectator areas.
- All non-2.4Ghz radios must use the frequency board to avoid conflicts.
- There is to be NO ARMING of ESC's in the car park. Take your aircraft to the pit area before connecting the flight battery.
- All pilots in control of an aircraft must be within the designated piloting area.
- For safety, spectators must remain in the spectator area.
- If you need to enter the display area, notify those in the piloting area before proceeding.
- SPARKS is an alcohol free event. If you choose to have a drink, you won't be flying anymore.
